Addysg Arbennig

Yr ALNCO , Mrs Rayanne Rogers, sy'n gyfrifol am addysg arbennig gyda Mrs Nicola Phillips wedi ymgymryd â'r rôl hwn yn ei habsenoldeb. Caiff plant ag Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig eu cofnodi ar gofrestr AAA'r Ysgol, a chaiff hwn ei adolygu yn rheolaidd. Ar hyn o bryd mae 30% o ddisgyblion ar y gofrestr hwn.

Special needs

Mrs. Rayanne Rogers ALNCO is responsible for Special Educational Needs with Mrs Nicola Phillips is undertaking this role in her absence. Pupils with special educational needs are placed on the SEN Register and this is reviewed regularly. At present there are 30% of pupils on this register.

All relevant policies have been reviewed as necessary. All special needs requirements regarding the admission of disabled personnel are assessed by the head teacher in order to ensure adequate provision, in accordance with the Equal Opportunities Policy.

Provision of Toilet Facilities for Pupils

For the younger pupils there are three unisex toilets. For the remainder of the pupils there are five toilets for the girls and three toilets and four urinals for the boys. There is also a disabled toilet and a staff toilet. All areas have soap and wash-basins and either hand dryers or paper towels. These facilities are cleaned at the end of each school day and any accidents during a school day are cleaned as quickly as possible

The main priority in the School Development Plan continues to be raising standards within the core subjects, i.e. Language, Mathematics and Science, including the statutory requirements of the literacy and numeracy framework. We continue to work on the fundamentals of assessment for learning and pupil welfare.

Mrs. Nicola Phillips is the Language Coordinator - Welsh and English - who leads on raising standards in both languages across the school. She also leads on the Welsh Language Charter initiative which focuses on promoting the use of Welsh inside and outside the classroom.

Miss Lisa Edwards is the Mathematics and Numeracy Coordinator, who leads on raising Mathematics and Numeracy standards across the school.

Miss Ffion James is the Science Coordinator, who leads on raising standards in Science across the school.

All relevant policies have been reviewed as necessary.

Attendance Policy

The policy includes the procedure for marking attendance.

School has to be informed of ALL absences. Parents are advised to contact school by 9.30 am so as to avoid being marked as absent WITHOUT consent. If no reason is given then the child is marked as being absent without consent, and a letter asking for a reason is sent home. If letter is returned with a valid reason stated then the marking is reversed to absent WITH consent. If however no reason is given in a letter then the marking of Unauthorized absence remains.

If a child's attendance is under 90% for the academic year then this is of concern to the Local Education Department and they will notify the Pupil Support Officer. **Our attendance policy strongly advised that parents do not take their child/children on holiday during term time.**

Lettings Policy

We are a community school and therefore the school is available to be hired for community use.

Every School day counts towards your child's future

Days off school add up to lost learning

A year has 365 days, 52 weeks, and 12 months

The school year has 195 days, 39 weeks, and 6 terms.

Five days in each school year are training days for teachers (= INSET days)

Pupils ,therefore ,attend school for 190 days . 175 days are non-school days.

A school day is divided into two sessions. A pupil,therefore,should attend school for 380 sessions.

10 days absence = 95% attendance

19 days absence = 90% attendance (four whole weeks)

29 days absence = 85% attendance

38 days absence = 80% attendance

47 days absence = 75% attendance

17 days off school every year means that you will probably obtain a whole grade lower in your exams than you are really capable of.

Pupils with less than 85% attendance are unlikely to gain 5 A-C GCSE's or any qualifications.

Punctuality

Being frequently late for school adds up to lost learning:

5 minutes late every day = 3 lost days a year

15 minutes late every day = being absent for 2 weeks a year

30 minutes late every day - being absent for 19 days a year
